## WCCCA MEETING MINUTES Arrowhead Clinic WCCCA Meeting August 7<sup>th</sup>, 2019

  - a. Updates to Extra Qualifier Sectional Proposal
    - i. 419 programs (Approximately 838 total)
    - ii. 323 responses
      - i. Approximately 1/3 have voted
      - ii. 78% positive from respondents
      - iii. Approximately 63% of those respondents favor using 29% to determine extra qualifiers.
    - iii. This probably will not happen with 70% response from all schools
    - iv. Another email will be coming in the first week of the season
      - i. Include language about the need for responses
      - ii. District Reps will likely reach out to schools
    - v. 63% said 29% as the percentage for the extra qualifier
    - vi. WIAA or Coaches Advisory decides? How aggressive should they be?
    - vii. There is inconsistency from the WIAA about how many responses are needed
    - viii. This differs from 4K/5K given that it is overwhelming in support so far
    - ix. Will they allow another team to attend state? The answer is not known. Jim Newman will not answer the direct question.
    - x. What if 20 teams was a maximum? For example, what if Division 1 went down to 16 teams and had a maximum of 4 extra qualifiers?
